By issuing visas at the point of arrival, the Ministry aims to bolster convenience for travellers while sustaining security measures.

This initiative will simplify travel logistics for both tourists and business visitors as it eliminates the need for prior visa applications, thereby reducing bureaucratic obstacles and waiting times. Consequently, it positions Namibia as a more welcoming and tourist-friendly destination, poised to attract a broader spectrum of both visitors and investors. As a crucial entry point for maritime trade and tourism, Walvis Bay harbour's role in driving economic prosperity cannot be overstated.

Travelers can also apply for visas on arrival at Hosea Kutako International Airport, Walvis Bay Airport and the border posts Trans Kalahari, Katima Mulilo, Ngoma, Impalila Island, Oshikango, Moheumbo, Ariamsvlei, Noordoewer and Oranjemund.

The visa upon arrival costs N\$1200 and is valid for 90 days.
